Request for Expression of Interest

1. The Government of Liberia has applied for financing to the World Bank toward the cost of the Smallholder Agriculture Transformation and Agribusiness Rehabilitation Project (STAR-P) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for individual consulting services for **Recruiting the Services of a Consultant to provide a Resettlement Policy Framework (RPF) for the Smallholder Agriculture Transformation and Agribusiness Revitalization Project in Bomi, Cape Mount, Margibi, Nimba and Lofa Counties.**

2. The scope of assignment includes, but not limited to preparing an acceptable Resettlement Policy Framework (RPF) based on an assessment of activities that may involve involuntary resettlement as defined by the World Bank. This study will focus on the project's targeted counties-Lofa, Bomi, Nimba, Cape Mount and Margibi Counties.

At the minimum, the study is expected to prepare the RPF based on the most accurate and available information on the groups who may potentially be affected by the project defined as "those whose land may be acquired, may be relocated, or whose income or livelihoods may be displaced by the project.

The study will also profile the current programs and donor resources for supporting governments' commitment and capacity to work on Resettlement issues in the sector.

3. The Ministry of Agriculture now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Individual Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and at least five years relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are: **description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among key staff, methodology in achieving the desired objectives of the assignment, specific experience relevant to the assignment and experience in the region.**

4. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers January 2011 and revised July 1, 2014 ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. In addition, please refer to the following specific information on conflict of interest related to this assignment: relationship with Borrower's staff: Consultants (including their experts and other personnel, and sub-consultants) that have close business or family relationship with a professional staff of the Borrower (or of the project implementing agency, or of a recipient of a part of the loan) who are directly or indirectly involved in any part of: (i) the preparation of the TOR for the assignment (ii) the selection process for the contract, or (iii) the supervision of such contract may not be awarded a contract, unless the conflict stemming from this relationship has been resolved in a manner acceptable to the Bank throughout the selection process and the execution of the contract.

5. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Individual **Consultant Selection (ICS)** Method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
