Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's [\*Guidelines: Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers \(Procurement in Investment Project Financing – Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services; July 2016\) and revised November 2017, July 2018, November 2020, September 2023 and September 2025 and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers \("Procurement Guidelines"\)\*](#), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. The document will be sent by hand-delivery or through soft copy.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below and placed in the tender box on or before **2<sup>ND</sup> July 2026** at 1400 hours or 2:00pm Monrovia time. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on **2<sup>ND</sup> July** at 14:05 hours or 2:05pm Monrovia time.

7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security, of US\$6,000.00 (Six Thousand United States Dollars) from a reputable bank.
