The Government of Liberia has received funding from the World Bank in support of the Regional Disease Surveillance Systems Enhancement (REDISSE-II) Project and intends to apply part of the credit for the recruitment of a Human Health Project Officer for the Project.

Main Duties

The Human Health Project Officer will coordinate the planning and implementation of human health activities, and ensure timely and effective implementation of REDISSE activities within the conceptual framework of One Health. The Human Health Project Officer will also support the strengthening of surveillance, laboratory systems, emergency preparedness and response, and workforce.

The Ministry of Health now invites eligible (“Individuals”) to indicate their interest in providing the services as per the below qualification requirement.

Qualifications and Requirements:

The minimum qualification and requirements for the position are:

- Holds a Master’s degree in nursing, health sciences, public health, economics, social science and environmental health
- Have a solid professional experience of at least 3 years in health systems and programs, knowledgeable about the IHR Strategies and country priority diseases or events
- Relevant work experience and technical support to human and environmental health diseases and/or events
- Have the capacity for sound communication and community entry/engagement skills
- Strong knowledge of the health systems, social sciences and related fields with capacity in technical documentation
- Deep understanding of fieldwork in the areas of human and environmental health
- Have the capacity to work with computer and computer software: Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint.
- Excellent English writing skills

- Ability to meet tight deadlines and to work effectively under pressure, including in a multi-cultural environment

Duration of the Assignment: The assignment is for 12 months or 1 year and it's renewable subject to satisfactory performance and availability of funding.
