1. The *Government of Liberia* has received financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) and intends to apply a part of the proceeds to the financing of this procurement. The use of any IFAD financing shall be subject to IFAD's approval, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the financing agreement, as well as IFAD's rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its officials, agents and employees shall be held harmless from and against all suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and liability of any kind or nature brought by any party in connection with *Tree Crop Extension Project II – TCEP II*
2. TCEP II is designed to reach 15,000 beneficiaries including 10,000 smallholder cocoa producers who are members of kuu groups and Farmers Field Schools (FFS); 5,000 farmers who will benefit from access to roads, input supply and market linkages and 600 farmers who will benefit as a result of job creation along the value chain.
3. The employer now invites sealed bids from eligible entities ("bidders") for the execution and completion of *construction of 57.58km of Feeder Roads in Bong and Lofa Counties in Liberia* which are being bid as a unit price contract based on the bill of quantities.
4. This IFB is open to all eligible bidders who wish to participate. Subject to the restrictions stipulated in the bidding document, eligible bidders may associate with other bidders to enhance their capacity to successfully carry out the works.
5. The works, and the contract/s expected to be awarded, are divided into the following lots:

**Bidders have the option to bid for one or more lots; but they will only be contracted for a maximum of one lot. However, in the event that a bidder wins more than one lot, the lot with the higher price will be awarded to the bidder; if the lots are of the same value, any one of the lots will be awarded to the bidder**

6. A contractor will be selected using the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method in accordance with the IFAD Procurement Handbook accessible at [www.ifad.org/project-procurement](http://www.ifad.org/project-procurement). The NCB process will include a review and verification of qualifications and past performance, including a reference check, prior to the contract award.
7. Please note that a pre-bid conference *will* be held as described in the Bid Data Sheet (“BDS”), Section III of the bidding document.
8. Bidders interested in submitting a bid shall purchase the bidding document against payment of a non-refundable fee of **USD200 (Two hundred US Dollars)** by sending an e-mail or letter, giving full contact details of the bidder, to [evah@moa.gov.lr](mailto:evah@moa.gov.lr). This will ensure that the bidders receive updates regarding this bidding document.

*Potential bidders are to deposit all fees for bid documents in the below account and submit deposit slip to the finance office for receipt. Bid not registered with the bank will not be eligible for evaluation. This account is signature as the project accounts.*

**All bids must be accompanied by the following:**

- a. A copy of a valid business registration certificate from the country in which bidder/contractor is registered;
- b. copy of valid tax clearance certificate from the country in which bidder/contractor is registered;
- c. Experience and Technical capacity of bidder/Contractor in similar works.
- d. A copy of the Ministry of Public Works classification certificate- Class (A.2,3,4,6,8 & A.10) Some Road Works) or its equivalent in foreign bidder/contractor’s Country.
- e. A list of recent contracts performed (at least two similar works) with evidence of completion within the last 5 years.
- f. Bid Security in the amount and format specified for each lot from **a reputable bank not Insurance Company.**

Bids must be delivered to the address and in the manner specified in the BDS ITB 22.1, no later than: **March 27<sup>th</sup> 2026 at 10:00 AM.**

9. Bidders should be aware that late bids will not be accepted under any circumstance and will be returned unopened at the written request and cost of the bidder. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security (as required) in the manner and amount specified in the Bid Data Sheet.
10. Please note that electronic bids *not* be accepted.
