Assignment: Individual Consultancy to recruit Thirty (30) County Facilitators for the RETRAP

The Government of Liberia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **Rural Economic Transformation Project (RETRAP)** and intends to apply part of the proceeds to recruit thirty (30) county facilitators for the RETRAP.

The services to be carried out by the county facilitator under the supervision of the Deputy Project Coordinator include: working with the benefiting communities, sensitize, mobilize, and facilitate the preparation of their business plans. Community-Level Facilitators will be hired by and report to the PIU as Consultants. They will collect data on farmers field days, exchange visits, farmers field school, study tours, mass media and ICT-based outreach channels, information and knowledge sharing events, such as exhibitions, workshops, conferences, on-farm use of new technology. For example: improved seeds, seedlings, livestock, poultry, fertilizer, agro-chemicals, agricultural equipment and farm machinery. They will collect data on commercial facilities/markets constructed/rehabilitated, the number of PPD organizations and FBOs receiving technical assistance or training from the project.

The Ministry of Agriculture now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in performing the Services. Interested Individual Consultants should provide updated Curriculum Vitae (CV) and relevant documents indicating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

The shortlisting criteria include Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture Science, Agribusiness, Economics, Business Administration or other related field from a recognized institution of higher learning.
