TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

The Ministry of Agriculture (MOA) invites applications from interested and qualified Liberians from all fifteen (15) counties to participate in the Agricultural Machinery Operators and Maintenance Technicians Training Program.

This initiative aims to develop a skilled workforce capable of operating, servicing, and maintaining agricultural machinery to support the Ministry's Mechanization Hubs and expand access to mechanization services for farmers across Liberia. Upon successful completion of the training, participants will be deployed to Mechanization Hubs in **Bong** - Garmue and Bong Mines, **Margibi** - Kakata, **Lofa** - Foyah and Kolahun, **Montserrado** - Bentol, and **Nimba** - Gbedin and Tappita.

The training program will cover:

- ✓ Operation of tractors and other agricultural machinery and equipment, including power tillers, rice harvesters, and threshers.
- ✓ Preventive maintenance and routine servicing of agricultural machinery.
- ✓ Diagnosis, troubleshooting, and repair of agricultural equipment.
- ✓ Occupational health and safety in agricultural mechanization.
- ✓ Agricultural mechanization service delivery.

Applicants must:

- ✓ Be a Liberian citizen.
- ✓ Be under fifty (50) years of age.
- ✓ Have a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- ✓ Demonstrate an interest in agriculture, agricultural machinery, or technical maintenance.
- ✓ Be physically fit and able to participate in intensive practical and field-based training.
- ✓ Be willing to serve in any assigned county upon successful completion of the training.
- ✓ Not be a current employee of the Ministry of Agriculture.
- ✓ Possess good communication and interpersonal skills.

- ✓ Mechanics or mechanical engineering.
- ✓ Agricultural engineering.
- ✓ Vocational or technical education.
- ✓ Driving and operation of heavy-duty equipment.
- ✓ Agricultural production or farm operations.

- ✓ A cover letter.
- ✓ A current Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- ✓ Copies of academic and professional certificates.
- ✓ A copy of a valid national identification document.
- ✓ Two recent passport-size photographs.
- ✓ Relevant technical certificates or proof of practical experience, where applicable.
