Scholarship Opportunity for Veterinary Degree Training Abroad

The Ministry of Agriculture (MOA), through the **HeSP Security Program**, is pleased to invite applications from qualified Liberians for an overseas **Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine (BVM) Degree Training Program**.

This scholarship aims to strengthen Liberia's veterinary workforce by developing competent professionals who can support animal health, livestock production, disease surveillance, food safety, and national agricultural development.

The program provides:

- **Four (4) scholarships** for qualified Liberian applicants to pursue a **four-year Veterinary Degree Program** at an accredited university abroad.
- **Eight (8) scholarships** for eligible **in-service Ministry of Agriculture staff** to undertake veterinary degree training under the same program.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants should:

- Be a Liberian citizen.
- Hold a BSc in Animal Science, Biology, Zoology, or a related field with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Have strong academic results in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Mathematics (WAEC/WASSCE).
- Demonstrate a strong interest in Veterinary Science.
- Meet the admission requirements of the host university.
- Be medically fit and committed to serving Liberia's livestock and agriculture sectors after graduation.

For the in-service category, applicants must:

- Be a confirmed employee of the Ministry of Agriculture.
- Receive endorsement from their supervisor and the Ministry.
- Demonstrate satisfactory performance and commitment to public service.

Application Requirements:

Applicants should submit:

- A completed application letter expressing interest.
- Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- Certified copies of academic certificates and transcripts.
- A copy of a valid passport or other national identification.
- Two recommendation letters (academic or professional).
- A personal statement outlining career goals and commitment to Liberia's veterinary sector.
- Two passport-size photographs.

Selection Process:

Shortlisted candidates will undergo a competitive assessment, which may include:

- Document screening
- Written assessment (where applicable)
- Interview
- Verification of credentials

The application should be submitted no later than July 31, 2026, by email to amangou@moa.gov.lr.
