DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the overall guidance of the FAO Representative in Liberia, and technical supervision of the FAO Regional and Sub-Regional Offices, the TCDC Consultant shall work in close collaboration with the Deputy Minister of Agriculture for Planning and Development/MoA, the project team leader and staff, and shall be directly responsible for the following lines of duties

1. Review the purpose, objectives and outputs of the project with the FAOR, Government Authorities, and the other experts in the project, and review the TORs for the assignment essentially to determine relevance of its elements, make adjustments as and where necessary, and plan its implementation;
2. In collaboration with the Government authorities, FAOREP, RAF and the other experts in the project, revise the Work Plan for implementation of the project;
3. In collaboration with National consultant, assess and evaluate Liberia past agricultural/livestock survey tools and methodology (questionnaire, classifications, instruction manual, sample frame, sample design, etc.);
4. Prepare a cost-effective methodology and tools (questionnaire, classifications, instruction manuals, sample frame, sample design, survey tabulation plan) for the pilot agricultural survey including vulnerability assessment module;
5. Assist in the organization of the field work;
6. Assist in census personnel training;
7. Assist in data analysis and report writing;
8. Prepare mission reports and an Assignment Report in line with a format to be agreed with FAO.
